## Fullerlea Carey House

Fullerlea is a very special Colonial home listed in the National Registry of Historical Districts. It was built in 1850 and served as the Episcopal parsonage for over 100 years. Additions and a major renovation were completed in the 1980s by William Polk Carey, an American businessman and philanthropist, founder of Carey Institute for Global Good and benefactor of Rensselaerville. Now it's a 5 BR/5 BA retreat with many options, such as intimate dinners in front of the kitchen fireplace or large parties that flow from the dining room to the deck, patio, gardens and yard. The front & back stairs allow separate access to the primary and other bedrooms. Detached 3-car garage with apartment/family room with bath, kitchen and patio overlooking stonewalls, park-like lower field and seasonal stream. There are multiple sheds for storage, gardening, and equipment. Steps away is the 2000 acre [Huyck Preserve](#) and [Lake Myostosis](#) with miles of hiking trails through forever-protected lands.
