1712 House

The 1712 House was built in 2002, based on the design of the historic Jean Hasbrouck House in Huguenot Village in New Paltz. It features historically accurate details including hand hewn beams, wide plank floors, custom furniture, iron hardware and period artifacts. This extraordinary house—along with much of the furniture—was designed by the owner, and hand-built by local craftsmen. Set on 80 pristine acres abounding with streams, ponds, and a 20 acre manicured lawn, this park-like estate is completely private yet minutes from the hamlet of Stone Ridge. The house provides a comfortable feel, with ample space to serve family and guests. The seven bedrooms in three wings offer privacy and quiet. There are places to mingle for activities as well as tranquility and quiet solitude. There are two living rooms, a grand kitchen, lower level recreational area with fireplace, kitchenette, nine bathrooms, a serving room, gym and dance floor.
