



## The Jacob Dunham House

With a majestic hilltop setting, The Jacob Dunham House boasts views of the Catskill Mountains, with elegant privacy landscaping reminiscent of English gardens. The original house was built in 1790 by Jacob Dunham, a privateer who sailed the Hudson River and the high seas, by commission for private commercial ship owners. In 1895, an addition was built in the Greek Revival style. Gloriously restored by a renowned designer, the home offers three bedrooms, three baths and four fireplaces. Original details abound in this lovely center hall, each room is light, airy and roomy. The first floor offers a wide formal entrance, a bright chef's kitchen with original 1790 fireplace and large pantry, formal living and dining rooms. On the second floor there are three bedrooms, including a master suite with large dressing room. Walk down the hill to shops and restaurants on Main Street in the happening Village of Catskill.
